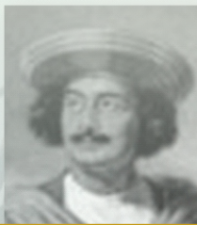

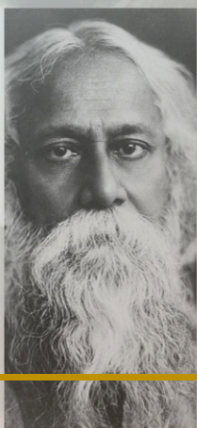

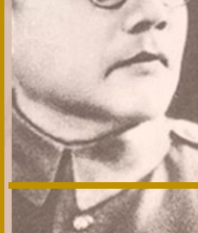

Biswa Bangla Gate
